Minutes for monthly meeting held on October 6, 2009

Paul Yorkis, chairperson, described the newly resurrected **Middlesex, Norfolk, Worcester Democratic Alliance PAC**. The purpose of this PAC is to give small town Democratic Committees the opportunity to schedule educational and informational sessions, to share information, to coordinate and implement efforts of regional interest and to sponsor events such as candidate nights. Each town can select two representatives (Paul Yorkis and Sue Rorke were selected), who along with each town committee chairperson, can vote at PAC meetings. Barby stressed the importance of the MDTC's history of accomplishments. She may be able to start a document that other knowledgeable members could then add to. She has photos that Sue can scan and post to the web. John suggested a presentation to the Historical Society.
